- What:** ***Year Long Professional Development Academy***
This Academy is a professional development program to provide support for high school math teachers with a focus on interventions and results for students in the math intervention classes. These interventions can also be used in regular math classes. During the training, teachers will identify and align resources, technology, and assessment currently used with the content. New intervention strategies will be also taught by the presenters with time for teachers to implement in the classroom and have follow up/support at monthly PD sessions.
